## 2 AIMS OF THE FCE

- 1) To determine the World Champions male and female
  - \* World Champion in Paraski individual – male and female separately
  - \* World Champion in Team Paraski
    - male and mixed gender teams together and
    - separately female teams and junior teams (subject to CR PS 4.4.8)
  - \* World Champion in Paraski Junior (junior is a person under the age of 24 years or whose 24th birthday occurs during the calendar year 2019 i.e. born 1995 or later)
    - male and female separately (subject to CR PS 4.4.8)
  - \* Winner of the Masters Class Paraski (Master is a person over the age of 50 or whose 50th birthday occurs during the calendar year 2019)
    - male and female separately (subject to CR PS 4.4.8)
- 2) To determine the standing of the competing teams, to update FAI world ranking list and establish FAI records.
- 3) To promote and develop Paraski Parachuting.
- 4) To exchange experience and strengthen friendly relations between the skiing sport parachutists of all nations.
- 5) To allow participants to share and exchange experience, knowledge.

## 6 COMPETITION SITES

### SKI RACE:

There will be 3 location options for the ski race. Preferred ski race location is Ski area Herlíkovice, RACE course. In case of insufficient snow cover, the ski race will be moved to the „RED“ slope. In case of insufficient snow cover in Herlíkovice, the ski race will be moved to Špindlerův Mlýn.

### Race course option 1 – Ski area Herlíkovice

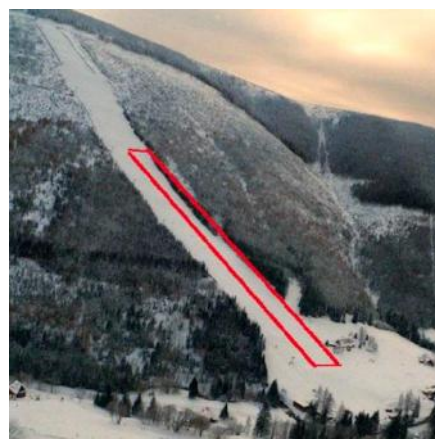
Ski slopes in Herlíkovice have regularly hosted many skiing competitions as well as Paraski competitions in the past.

### Race course option 3 – Ski area Špindlerův mlýn (Stoh)

Length of the course: 800 – 1000m  
Number of gates: 35 – 40

Ski course in Špindlerův mlýn (Stoh) is a host to many ski races in Czech Republic. It is a fairly steep ski slope; the race course starts at the bottom half of the hill.



## PARACHUTING – ACCURACY LANDING

The parachuting discipline will take place in the Ski area Bubákov. The landing area is at 700m (MSL). The helicopter landing area is situated approx. 150m away from the landing area. The site has already successfully hosted the Paraski World Cup Series competition in 2018.



### 7 AIRCRAFT

Eurocopter AS350 or similar helicopter for 4 competitors.  
Dropping speed approx. 60 – 80 kt.

### 8 PRE-EVENT TRAINING

On Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2019 there will be training jumps possible from 12:00. The ticket price will be 35€. Exit altitude will be 1000m.

Pre-manifesting will be required (included in the registration forms).

### 9 ACCOMMODATION DETAILS

Depending on the participation, the event participants will be accommodated in one or two hotels in the city of Vrchlabí within 5km from the competition sites. Breakfast and dinner will be provided by the organizer. There will be lunch vouchers given to the participants for their use at the competition sites.

## 10 SPORT EQUIPMENT

The use of an AAD is highly recommended. Main parachute must be initiated by 600m/2000ft (800m/2600ft for A and B license). Use of head protection is mandatory for both disciplines. Valid parachuting license and FAI sporting license is required.

## 12 JUDGING AND SCORING

Austrian target system "Airshots" (run by Franz Singraber) will be used during the competition. The results will be published as required by the FAI/IPC rules.

## 13 MEDICAL CARE DETAILS

A fully trained and well-equipped paramedic will be at the competition sites during the period of the competition. The local hospital in Vrchlabí is less than 5km away. Doping tests according to WADA regulations are possible.

## 14 INSURANCE DETAILS

Organizer will arrange liability insurance covering competitors, officials, judges, etc. It is strongly recommended to the competitors to have their own insurance covering all medical expenses and repatriation in case of injury valid for the Czech Republic. As a law requirement, each competitor must have a valid third-party liability insurance for the parachuting activity. The minimum amount of coverage is 2 000 000 CZK (=80 000€).

## 15 VISA INFORMATION

There are no visa requirements for residents of the European Union and USA. More information can be found at: <https://www.mzv.cz/jnp/en/index.html>.

Participants / delegation members in need of visa for entering EU/Czech Republic will receive visa support by the Organizer (letter of invitation) upon request which cannot be done later than January 12<sup>th</sup>.
